Gerry Jensen demonstrated a weighted Christmas Ornament Stand. He explained how he turns the wood on the lathe, inserts the weight in the bottom, bends the wire and cuts the shape on the band saw. After his demonstration he invited members to come forward and try making a stand.





After Gerry's demo we had lathes open for hands on help. Tim Harteau is explaining how to properly hold and use a hollowing tool, then members were able to give the hollowing tool a try. We also had a lot of discussions on finishes, glues, sanding, and using resins in wood.
