Tim's demo was on the different systems used for coring bowls. With these coring systems you can get three or four bowls out of one log. Tim used his One Way Coring System and Mark Brienen let him demo his McNaugton Coring System. These systems can be pricy with the One Way base set at \$225.00 and the McNaugton set at \$329.00. Tim went through the pros and cons of each coring system. The first bowl will be small, the second bowl will be medium size and the third bowl will be larger.


Artisan Summer 2023 Class Catalog
