Our demonstrators for the February meeting were the husband & wife team of Alan and Lauren Zenreich. They demonstrated their techniques for unique wood turned jewelry. Alan demonstrated creation pendants using multi-axis turning, boring, and beading using the Joyner Off-Center Jig, while Lauren demonstrated embellishment of pendants using inks, paints, etc.

This demo was a first for BayLake Woodturners in that Alan and Lauren were actually demonstrating live from their studio in northern New Jersey via the internet. Alan is a pioneer in the use of telecommunications technology for live demonstrations. A growing number of professional turners and demonstrators are adopting this technology to provide live, cost-effective demonstrations for local turning clubs.
